

A part-time/full time Project Manager position is immediately available in the translational research group led by Dr. Lona Mody, MD, M.Sc, in the Department of Internal Medicine/Division of Geriatric and Palliative Care Medicine at the University of Michigan.

As part of various NIH funded projects, we are studying the translational epidemiology of multi-drug resistant organisms and infections in aging populations as well as designing innovative interventions to reduce these adverse outcomes. In addition, we have an active microbiology lab where we process organisms to trace the source of any new strains and evaluate the impact of our intervention on specific strains.

Our most recent research project is funded through AHRQ RO1 mechanism to design and implement interventions that bring hospitals and post-acute care facilities together to reduce infections and antibiotic resistance.

This position will entail:

1. Developing and maintaining all study procedures and policies
2. Developing, organizing and leading meetings with key stakeholders and partners
3. Preparing educational materials with an option to lead these sessions at local facilities
4. Assisting in data entry, synthesis and presentations
5. Conduct literature search, preparing reference libraries, prepare and submit manuscripts
6. Ability to work with a large team of field and laboratory staff, establish and maintain collaborative relationships with administrators, faculty and staff
7. Ensure program compliance with government regulations, University policies and institutional review board; preparing NIH reports and IRB applications and renewals

Requirements: Masters in Public Health (or a related field such as Nursing Degree) and a high level of intellectual curiosity. Track record of publications and prior work experience is a plus.
